ELIGIBLE COMPETITORS: All competitors must be holders of a current, valid and relevant Motorsport UK (MSUK) / MI Racing Licence & Medical Certificate or an equivalent ASN Racing Licence with authorisation from the ASN endorsed thereon to enter foreign permitted events. Licences will be examined at signing-on.

INVITED CLUBS / C'SHIPS: MI / MSUK

ENTRIES AND STARTERS: The organisers have the right to select or refuse entries.

The maximum for each practice is as per the Track Licence for the circuit.

The maximum for each race is as per the Track Licence for the circuit. The minimum is 10. Should any of the minimum figures for each race class not be reached the organisers have the right to cancel / amalgamate races or classes as necessary. Additionally, regardless of minimum numbers, the organisers have the right to amalgamate classes as necessary.

ENTRY DEFINITIONS: Each entry will qualify for 3 personnel passes for the meeting. Each entry will qualify the competitor for a listing in the official programme of the sponsor / team name. This listing will be a maximum of six words and must contain no offensive or misleading statements. All other restrictions on certain types of advertising must be respected. For all entries made supported by an International or National Entrants Licence, the listing in the official programme must match the title on the Entrants Licence.

ACCEPTANCE / REFUSAL OF ENTRIES: Entries will be accepted up to the closing date specified on this form subject to the maximum numbers specified above. Late entries received after the closing date specified will be accepted or refused at the discretion of the Club, with a late entry fee of £25.00. **No entries whatsoever will be accepted**

after 12.00 noon on the **Tuesday** prior to the meeting unless a prior arrangement has been made. To meet this deadline, completed entry form and payment must have been received by the Secretary of the Meeting. Any change of entry must be in accordance with MSUK **D25.1.12**. Refund of entry will be assessed on a case by case basis and any withdrawal of entry must be notified to the Secretary of the Meeting at least 48 hours in advance of the start of the event. Any refund will be subject to an administration charge of £20.00.

Closing date for entries = Tuesday, 25th April 2023. Late entry fee applies after this date = £25.00.

RESULTS AND PROTESTS: Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after each race in a manner to be advised in the Final Instructions. Protests should be made in accordance with MSUK **C5**.

START POSITIONS: These will be determined by practice times. Grid & rolling starts will be used for classes, which will be outlined in the Final Instructions for the event. Start penalties will be in accordance with MSUK Regulations. There will be separate timed practice sessions for each class. Drivers must complete at least 3 laps to qualify for a place on the grid. Drivers practising out of session or who qualify only through familiarity of the circuit will be placed at the back of the grid in accordance with MSUK **Q12.9.3**. The Track Licence as issued by MSUK will dictate the number of starters for each class for each race.

SCRUTINEERING: All vehicles must comply with MSUK Vehicle, Formula and Tyre regulations. Competition numbers must conform to MSUK / MI Vehicle regulations. Details of scrutineering will be issued in the Final Instructions.

REGULATIONS: All other Regulations of the MSUK, C'ship Regulations and any other SR's issued by the organisers.

AWARDS: As per Championship Regulations.

INSURANCE: All competitors are insured in respect of Third Party liability during official practice and racing. For further details see the current MSUK Yearbook.

FINAL INSTRUCTIONS: Final Instructions will issue after the closing date as outlined above. Final Instructions will include instructions on accessing circuit, scrutineering times, timetable for event and any other relevant information required for the running of the race meeting.
